EASTER TRIDUUM

Maundy Thursday is the start of the Easter Triduum. The Easter Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season and ushers in the season of Easter. Although the Triduum spans the three chronological days from Holy Thursday to Easter Sunday, it is one liturgical service expressing the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The Triduum contains the celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper, Good Friday of the Lord's Passion, and the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord.
