According to the Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, Jesus Christ made a special promise, which she was to communicate to the whole world: My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. Truly, a "whole ocean of graces" is contained in these promises: I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (1109).
