### **ASK YOUR MP TO PROTECT LIFE IN THE NEW PARLIAMENT**

We are likely to face threats in the new Parliament on both beginning and end-of-life fronts. As the new Parliament begins, we are expecting attempts from MPs to introduce an extreme abortion law that would make it more likely that healthy babies are aborted at home for any reason, up to birth. On the end-of-life front, last week Lord Falconer introduced a Bill in the House of Lords to legalise assisted suicide and the Prime Minister has pledged that he will make time for MPs to vote on the introduction of assisted suicide.
